The Senior Honors Jazz Ensemble is the premier jazz ensemble for the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) in Maryland. This all-county honors jazz ensemble is made up of music students from high schools throughout MCPS. Each September these students audition for this prestigious ensemble. The ensemble rehearses weekly from early October to December and are featured at the annual MCPS Big Band Jazz Festival which began in 1978. The Senior Honors Jazz Ensemble is directed by an experienced secondary instrumental music teacher skilled in providing high quality jazz instruction. The ensemble performs big band jazz literature of the highest quality and from various jazz genres. Students are afforded the opportunity to demonstrate improvisation skills as soloists in addition to contributing to their respective section in the jazz ensemble.

Battlefield High School Zachary Saunders, Director of Orchestras

The Battlefield Philharmonia is the premiere string ensemble at Battlefield High School in Haymarket, VA. Formerly known as "Chamber Orchestra", the group has grown to include nearly 60 members and is currently completing its 13th season. Each and every year, this ensemble has earned superior ratings at district assessment, preparing the highest levels of graded repertoire available. Students have competed nationally in locations including New York City, Orlando, and Williamsburg, consistently earning top honors in all events. Our alumni include teachers, performers, and composers, with students accepted to many notable schools such as Eastman, The Cleveland Institute of Music, and Berkeley. Each musician completes three community service hours each year, volunteering their time to provide music at community events, fundraise for local charity organizations, and assist local schools and organizations with their concert performances. Zach Saunders is the current director of the ensemble, preceded by Katherine Thiele, who served in the position from 2004–2013.

Battlefield High School is home to over 170 orchestra students who all enroll in one of five classes and perform in one of the three orchestras.

The Battlefield Philharmonia is the program's flagship ensemble, including nearly eighty musicians. This group has had the privilege to perform in Orlando, Chicago, New York, and at the Kennedy Center as part of the 2017 Music in our Schools Month. Additionally, the Philharmonia celebrates thirteen straight years of superior ratings at district assessment, earning this honor each and every time since the program's inception in 2004.


This year, the Battlefield Philharmonia is excited to perform for the 2017 VMEA State Conference, while the Battlefield Chamber Players looks forward to a collaborative performance of Mozart's Requiem with Fairfax High School at the Hylton Performing Arts Center.

Zach Saunders is the current director, following Katherine Thiele, the program's founder, who served in the position until 2013.

About the director....

Zach Saunders holds a Master of Music in Viola Performance from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music. His principal teachers include Maggie Snyder, Andrea Houde, William Wassum, and Christian Colberg.

Zach has served as the principal violist of the CCM Philharmonia, CCM Chamber—Players, and the assistant principal violist of the Brevard Music Center Orchestra. He has performed solo recitals throughout the US and in Europe, including an appearance as a soloist with the Buckhannon Chamber Players and the Brevard Sinfonia.



While serving as the strings teacher at Battlefield High School, enrollment has grown from 95 students to over 170, with all performing ensembles consistently earning superior ratings at district assessment. Zach is a 2007 graduate of Chancellor High School and the Commonwealth Governor's School in Fredericksburg, Virginia where he earned the VBODA Sydney Berg Scholarship and served as a concertmaster/asst. concertmaster, respectively, of the NCVRO and All-Virginia Orchestras.
